Saturday, June 8 - Depart the USA on your overnight flight to Dublin. Get Plenty of sleep. This is gonna be a good one!

Sunday, June 9 - We meet our driver/guide, Corkman Lesley Daunt, board our luxury coach and head west to the wild and wonderful region known as Connemara. Stop for **tea/coffee and scones** along the way. Some time to relax after check-in before meeting your fellow travelers dinner. **Overnight: Abbeyglan Castle Hotel, Clifden (B, D)**

Monday, June 10 – First - breakfast! Then we'll enjoy **a cruise on Ireland's only fjord**, located in Killary, extending 10 miles in from the Atlantic, and forming the border between Galway and Mayo, with some of the most gorgeous scenery in Ireland. Next stop will be **Kylemore Abbey**, built in 1867, one of the most photographed locations in Ireland. Kylemore Abbey and the surrounding mountains and lakes are steeped in history of the region. Mr. Kennedy will regale you after dinner with some songs from this lovely part of Ireland. The Queen Of Connemara, or the Connemara Cradle song, perhaps?

Overnight: Abbeyglan Castle Hotel, Clifden (B, D)

Tuesday, June 11 - Breakfast, anyone? This morning we visit the **Connemara History & Heritage Center** which offers a unique insight into the history and heritage of this beautiful part of the West of Ireland. See how turf (peat) is cut and sample a drop of 'poitín' (moonshine for you Yanks!). The afternoon will be free to explore Clifden on foot, maybe wander into a pub or two?

Overnight: Abbeyglan Castle Hotel, Clifden (B, D)

Wednesday, June 12 – Breakfast - the most important meal of the month - then on to Galway City! Free time here before going south into the other-worldly Burren, a veritable moonscape of glacial limestone with majestic mountains, gentle valleys and babbling brooks. Its extraordinary array of flora and fauna make the Burren a tapestry of color with a deeply spiritual aura. Stop at the **Cliffs of Moher** and take in the stunning Clare coastline. Onward into the beautiful county of Kerry. After dinner, a few Kerry songs from himself and some musical colleagues. **Overnight: Dingle Skellig, Dingle (B, D)**

Thursday, June 13 – Another breakfast, and today we travel along the **Dingle Peninsula** to delight in the stunning views of the Slieve Mish Mountains, the shoreline of Dingle Bay and the open Atlantic Ocean. Near Sleah Head, Ireland's Westernmost point, we will be able to see the Blasket Islands offshore, and possibly America... Return to Dingle and dinner will be at our hotel. Who knows what musical interlude Seamus has planned for this evening? But it will be fun! **Overnight: Dingle Skellig, Dingle (B, D)**

Friday, June 14 – A hearty "Full Irish" breakfast, then we travel the short distance to the lovely town of Killarney. Some free time here to do a bit of shopping, see the Lakes, or maybe take a jaunting car ride over to Ross Castle in the National Park.

Saturday, June 15 – Come and get it! This morning we visit the world famous Blarney Castle in Co. Cork. You may climb to the top and kiss the stone if you would like to receive the 'gift of the gab'. Enjoy some time walking the grounds, in the shops or have a pint in the pub. Then onward to the lovely city of Kilkenny. Some free time this afternoon to explore the city on foot or relax in your city center hotel overlooking the magnificent Kilkenny Castle. Seamus knows a great pub called Seamus Delaney's where good times can be had! **Overnight: Rivercourt Hotel, Kilkenny (B, D)**

Sunday, June 16 – Yes, breakfast again, then we will meet a local guide for an informative and entertaining **walking tour** of this ancient city. Explore the lanes, streets and stories of this remarkable place. Next onto **Smithwicks Brewery**, learn about the brewing process, and enjoy a sample of the amber ale. This evening, a little exploration or a quiet pint in one of Kilkenny's many fine pubs before dinner in our hotel perhaps? **Overnight: Rivercourt Hotel, Kilkenny (B)**

Monday, June 17 – After breakfast we depart for the Capital City of Dublin where we'll enjoy **a panoramic city tour**. See the River Liffey, tranquil St. Stephen's Green, the seat of government at Leinster House and other public buildings. See some of Dublin's famous Georgian houses with their brightly painted doors, the remainder of the day will be free to explore Dublin independently. And our last musical session with Seamus. *sniff*. **Overnight: Camden Court Hotel, Dublin (B)**

Tuesday, June 18 - After breakfast depart for Dublin Airport where you'll clear US Customs, Border Protection (Passport) and TSA in time for a little last minute Duty-Free shopping. You'll arrive back in the U.S. as a "domestic" passenger making it convenient to connect to an onward flight or to exit the airport with ease. Slán abhaile! – Safe home! And Go raibh maith agat!
